Couples can choose from a list of options that feature drinks by the pool, specialty dining, relaxing spa treatments and shore excursions.

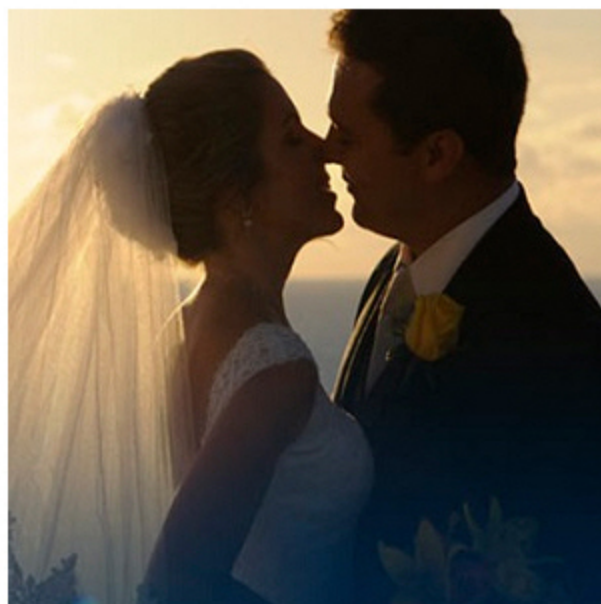
Gifts will be applied as an onboard credit for the couples to use during their honeymoon cruise.
